#### Abstract

Ron Gorchov (Hamilton Gallery, 20 West 57th Street): Ron Gorchov's basic format is a shield-shape canvas, whose richly underpainted monochrome surface is punctuated by a pair of parallel marks in contrasting or related colors. The canvases come in all sizes and hues, and they present certain ambiguities: the concave-convex shape of the shields; the relationship of the parallel marks to the surface (do they "break through"' or do they rest on top?).
